FURNITURE

Crib (you can start immediately or wait 6 months til your baby outgrows the bassinette)

Crib Sheets

Crib Blanket

Crib Pillow

Mobile (above crib)

Ocean Wonder's Aquarium (attach to side of crib)

Lamp

Night Light

Changing Table

Changing Table Pad

Changing Table Pad Covers

Receiving Blankets (place on top of table pad for an easy clean-up system)

Dresser

Bassinette (you can get one that has music, night light and vibrates) - good for up to 6 months

Bassinette Sheets

Sleep Positioner (so baby doesn't roll onto tummy)

Waterproof Liner

Rocking Chair or Glider (optional)

GEAR

Swing (Tori didn't like hers much but I know of others who LOVE them!)

Bouncer (the kind you hang from the doorway - good at around 6 months)

Bouncer: Ocean Wonders Aquarium – it sits on the floor and vibrates, Tori and Emily both loved it!

Baby Carrier (like a Baby Bjorn or Snugli – for hands-free movement so you can bring your baby with you)

High Chair (good around 6 months)

Play Yard (YES! This doubles as a crib or bassinette and keeps baby safe) - can be used for a few years

Infant Car Seat (I like Graco Travel Lite systems – good for one year then you need a larger seat)

Stroller (I like Graco Travel Lite systems. I also like the umbrella strollers for quick trips and light-weight)

Window shades for the car

FEEDING

Bottles (I like Avent)

Bottle Warmer

Bottle cleaners (brushes and drying rack)

Bottle sterilizer (the quick microwave kinds save lots of time)

Breastpump (optional)

Boppy Pillow (fabulous for nursing and then helping baby to sit up later)

Plates, Spoons, etc (you can wait til 6 months)

Bibs

Burp Cloths (or receiving blankets)

NURSERY

Monitor (I have the Summer brand which has the monitor so you can see the baby, too)
Hampers & Baskets (I like the wicker with the gingham pattern - choose something to match your baby's room)

BATHING

Towel (with hood)

Washcloths

Baby Shampoo & Body Wash

Lotion (optional as babies are naturally soft)

Powder

Diaper Rash Cream

Bath Toys (you'll want these around 3 months)

Bath Tub (optional - babies can use the sink for months!)

Healthcare Kit (includes nail clippers, nose syringe, medicine spoon)

First Aid Kit (including Baby Orajel, INFANTS *NOT CHILDRENS* Tylenol, bandages, etc)

Teether (I like the kind that freeze)

DIAPERS (lots of them – it's about 50¢ a poop!)

Diaper Genie (helps keep the air fresh and clean)

Diaper Warmer (really nice for baby's butt)

Diaper Bag (I'd wait – the hospital will give you one FREE and so will formula makers)

Diaper Stacker (optional, but I love mine and use it all the time, even two years later)

TOYS

Gymini (great! Playmat)

Anything educational -

Soothing CDs

Baby Einstein Books / Videos / DVDs

Soft Animal (you will get so many of these!)

Rattles and noisemakers - preferably colorful and soft

CLOTHES

Onesies

Nightwear – it's open at the bottom, no need to mess with snaps – makes for easy diaper changing at midnight.

Booties

Mittens (these are good esp. to help baby from scratching himself for the first couple of months)
